Location: 38 Nicholson Rd,
Thorndale

Meet: 9.30am at 38
Nicholson Rd,
Thorndale



Walk 3: Sunday 8 Nov 2015

Location: Girraween NP, Dr
Robert's Waterhole

Meet: 9.30am at the day use
area at Girraween NP,
Pyramids Rd, Wyberba
then convoy to Dr
Robert's Waterhole

What to bring:

- hat
- sturdy shoes
- sunscreen
- water
- camera
- binoculars
- morning tea/lunch

Follow 'Wildflower Walk' signs from meeting point to start of walk.

All walks start at 9:30am and aim to finish by 12:30pm

Groups will be led by botanical guides who can assist in the identification of wildflowers and answer questions.

Wildflower books will be available for purchase at each walk.

Bookings not required, just turn up on the day. Entry is free.
