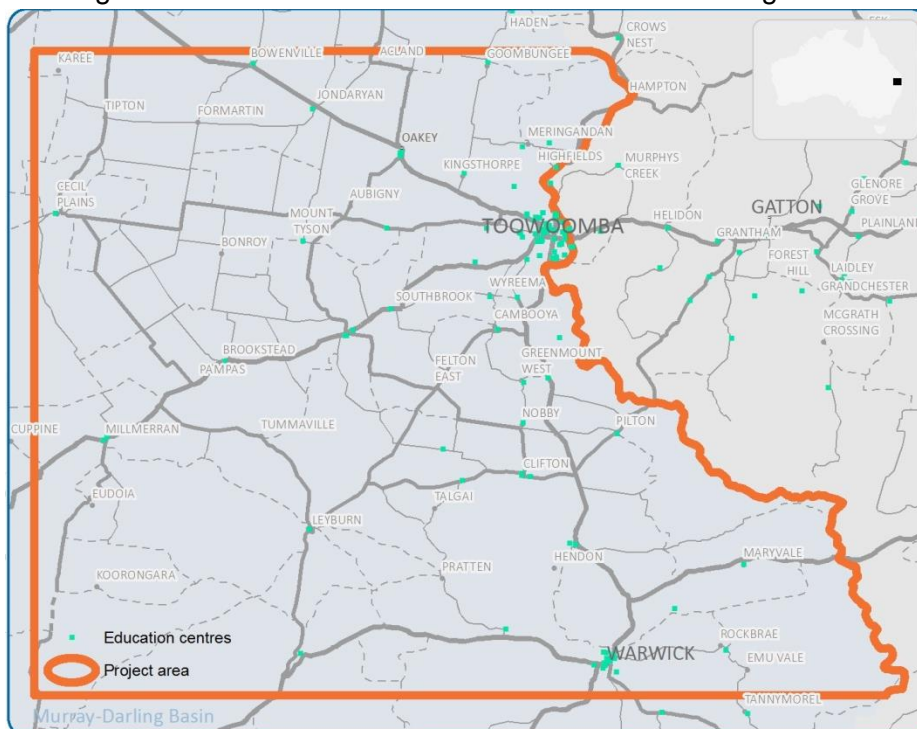


## Dirty Gloves in Schools Grants Frequently Asked Questions

### Am I in the eligible geographic area?

These grants are available to schools in the eastern Darling Downs



### Can I apply if I have already received funding from the Dirty Gloves in Schools program in the past?

Yes, however, priority will be given to schools that have not received funding in the calendar year.

Schools with outstanding final reports from previous grants will be ineligible for further funding until reports are finalised.

### Can I apply for funding for more than one project per round?

Yes, however, the maximum number of grants each school can receive each round is one.

### Can I submit my application after the due date?

No, applications received after the closing date will not be eligible. You may apply in the next round, however.

### **Can I apply for funding for a project that has already started?**

No. Money received from the grant must only be spent within the project timeline that the application outlines.

Extensions and add-ons to previous completed projects are eligible, and are counted as projects in their own right (e.g. adding an irrigation system to an existing native plant garden).

### **How do I apply?**

### **When will I be notified if our project is successful?**

Applicants will be advised of the funding outcomes on Friday March 17 2017

### **When will the project need to be completed and the final report sent through?**

Funds will need to be committed by 30 August 2017.

Final reports are due within a month of completion. Please note, QMDC and Total Tools will also be in contact with regard to publicity of the finalised project.

### **If successful, what are my obligations?**

Successful applications must:

- conduct the project according to the activities and budget for which the funding was approved and received
- provide a final report on outcomes of the project, including photographs by the date stated in the application form
- permit the Queensland Murray-Darling Committee and Total Tools Toowoomba to use your project final report and photographs for promotional purposes.
