## Land for Wildlife +Plus - Round 3 Funding

### Project aims

Queensland Murray-Darling Committee, through Land for Wildlife, is offering financial help to progress nature conservation on-ground projects on your property. QMDC will assist landholders registered with this program to improve their management and protection of Priority Ecosystems and Species. The eligible area for funding is shown on the map overleaf.

**Landholders will be eligible for a minimum of \$250 and a maximum of \$5,000 of funding for property works, depending on the environmental benefit gained.**

Landholders prepared to cost share will be preferred for funding (at least 30% cost share recommended).

Funding will be available for on-ground projects, including (but not restricted to):

- internal fencing of remnant and regrowth patches
- native species plantings for biodiversity conservation or habitat purposes
- tree guard supplies, for naturally regenerating plants and for revegetation plantings.
- equipment/supplies for weed control and feral animal control.

Please note, funding will not be available for boundary fencing, planting of exotic species or earthworks.

### Process of application

Fill out the **Expression of Interest** form and return it by **March 31, 2010**. Please provide as much detail as possible. You will then be contacted by a Land for Wildlife extension officer to discuss your application and organise a property visit if needed. At the property visit, a basic management plan will be written,

outlining the works to be undertaken, the values enhanced and how this will be managed in the future. You will then be required to develop a budget for the project, detailing funds sought and in-kind (cost share) contributions you intend to make.

These details will be needed by the assessment panel to determine the funding decision.

### Funding provisions and accounting

If successful, a *Letter of Agreement* between QMDC and you will be developed. This is a simple document outlining the partnership, the project and the monetary value involved. The *Letter of Agreement* will be finalised with the extension staff then signed by the QMDC CEO. Preference will be given to projects that are completed by **June 31, 2010**, with a brief report on progress, with photographs, submitted by this date to QMDC Regional Land for Wildlife Coordinator Kate Steel.

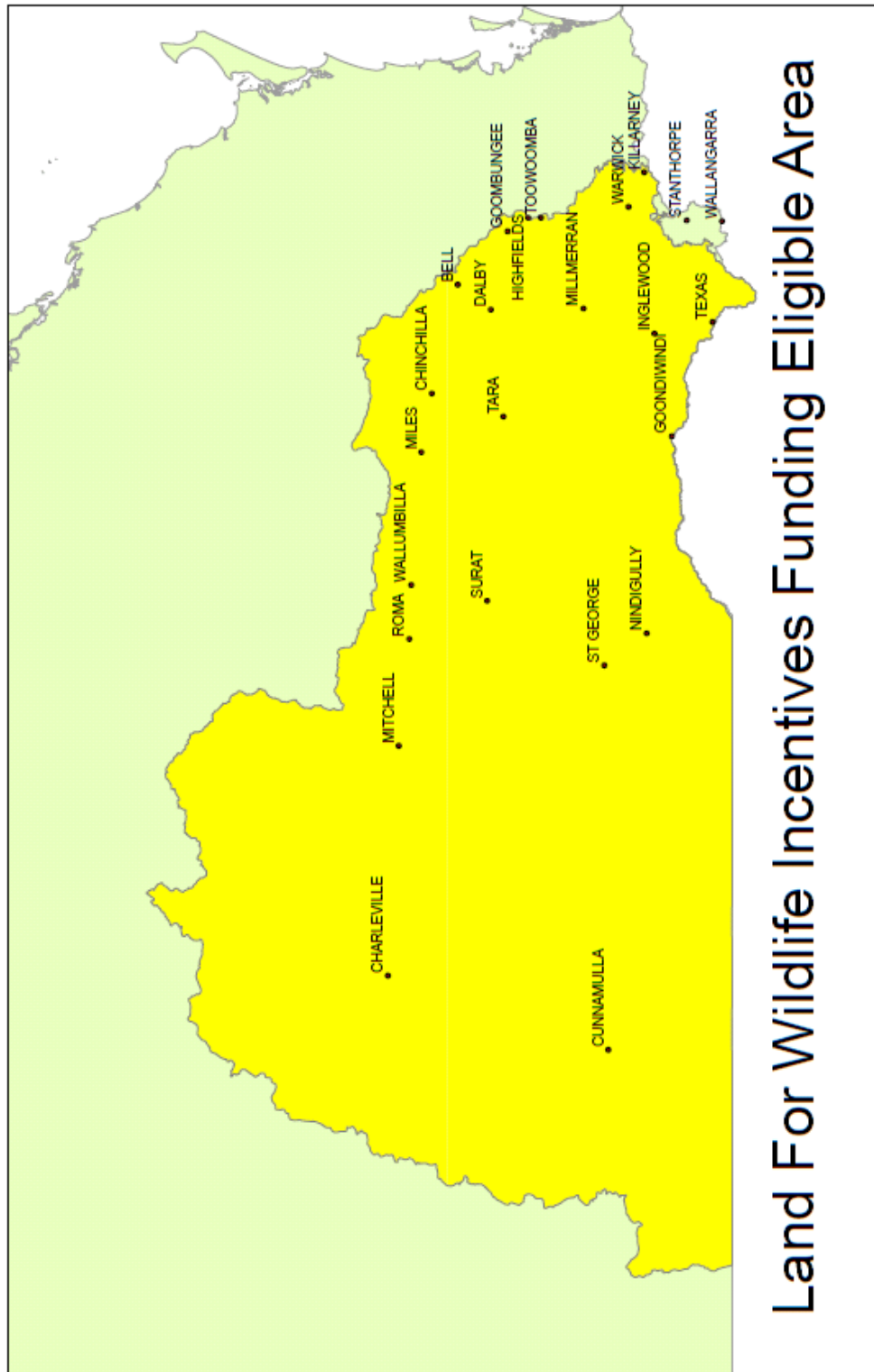
