European Carp are a high profile pest fish, now believed to make up to 80% of the total fish biomass within the river and creek systems of the Queensland Murray-Darling Basin.

There are many factors that influence the health of our region's water ways. The Carp Buster Series help's to raise awareness of these various factors and provide an opportunity for community members to come together and have a fun day out with the family!

**The 2010 series will begin with Goondiwindi in April 2010 and finish with Thallon in March in 2011.**

Each participant receives points for participation (50 points per competition) and for each carp caught (5 points).

The \$3,000 prize pool (\$500 donated by each fishing club) will be awarded to the top six point scorers across the series:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> – \$800
- 3<sup>rd</sup> – \$400
- 4<sup>th</sup> – \$300
- 5<sup>th</sup> – \$200
- 6<sup>th</sup> – \$100

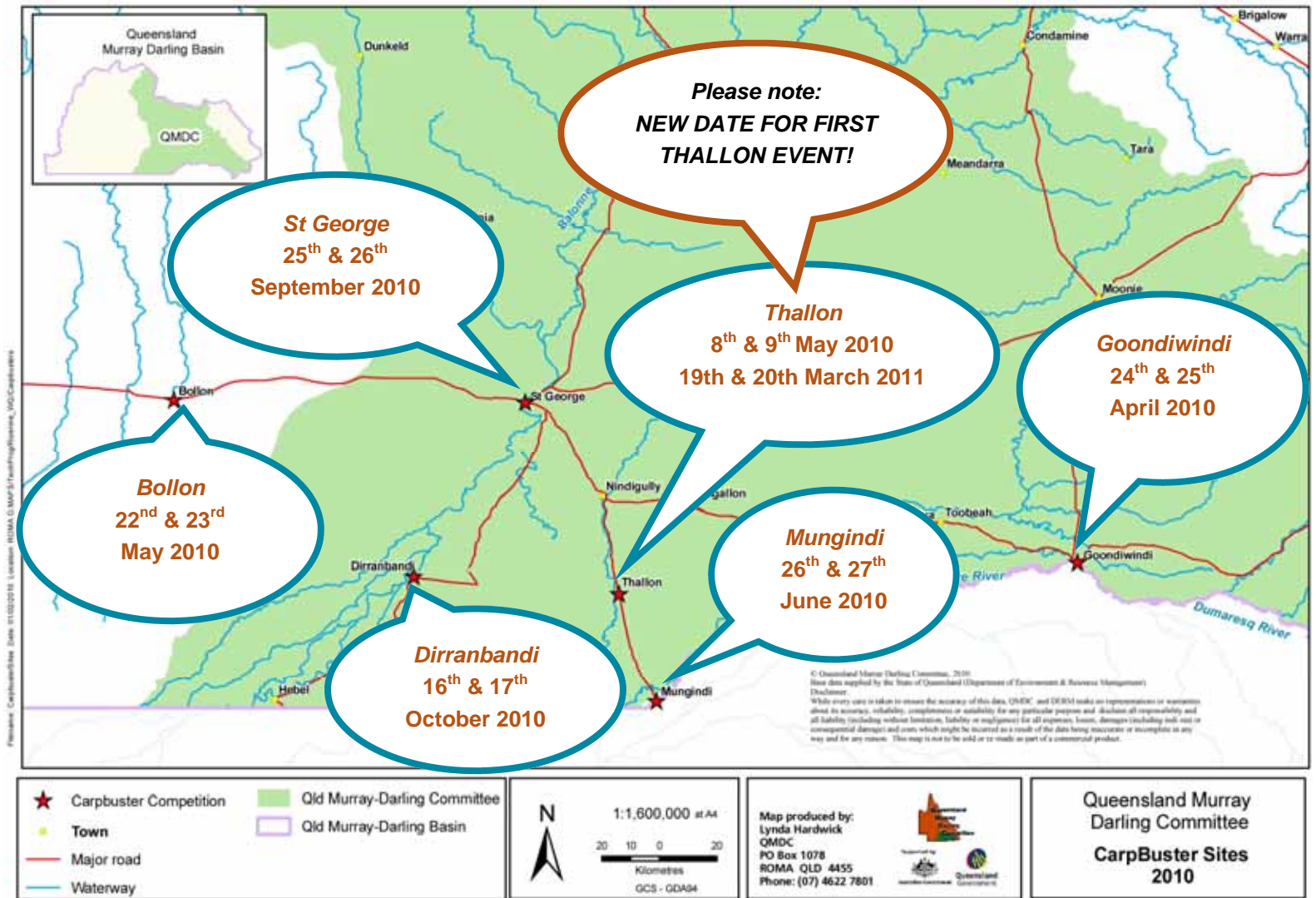
