The Landcare Discovery Centre offers a free borrowing library to the community. Located on Campbell Street, Toowoomba the library houses a collection of natural resource management/environment related books. The library provides information to support land managers and others in the community to manage our natural environment sustainably.

The Landcare discovery Centre is administered by the Queensland Murray-Darling Committee Inc. (QMDC). QMDC has a vision for the equitable, efficient and sustainable use of land, water and other environmental resources of the Queensland Murray-Darling Basin.

- Main task will be entering new library resources into the database. Training will be provided on the library software. Other tasks may include organising the collection on the shelves and handling loans.
