Naturally Resourceful aims to

1. Provide a pathway for women to take leadership responsibilities within the NRM field, and within their social, producer and political groups and committees.
2. Increase the knowledge base and commitment of participants to take responsibility, and to take action, for improved management of the environment in their day to day lives and within their communities.
3. Develop participant's self confidence to value their contributions and to encourage and support others, through their improved capacity for leadership coupled with their increased understanding of environmental issues.
4. Improve the understanding of participants about the links between good NRM practice and the social and economic viability of rural and farming communities.
5. Encourage participants to be advocates for learning within their communities.
