# Property Planning 2010



The Property Planning program guides students through the process of developing a working property management plan. The program includes a field trip to a commercial property to examine natural resource management, cultural heritage and primary production issues under the guidance of technical staff from the Queensland Murray-Darling Committee.

Teachers are provided with a detailed resource manual to guide student learning and students are provided with a workbook for the field trip. Students also have the option of entering their completed property management plan in the Property Plan Competition.

**Who:** The program is aimed at senior secondary Agriculture Science students

**Costs:** School registration — \$200

Includes:

- Property Planning Program teaching resources
- field trip activities led by experienced technical staff
- assessment of student property plans by technical staff
- student prize for winning plan

Student fee — \$10

Includes:

- workbook
- all equipment and resources for field activities
- the opportunity to meet and discuss career pathways with technical staff working in the natural resource management sector.



Students will undertake guided field investigations examining:

- soil and landscape
- cultural heritage
- vegetation and biodiversity
- water quality and use
- weeds and pest animals.
